Located on 94th Street, bayside, in Ocean City, Maryland, the newly built home of the non-profit Art League of Ocean City facility features a spacious two story gallery, a pottery studio, classrooms, art library and five working artist studios. The galleries display new exhibits of regional and local artists monthly, some of whom are Art League of Ocean City members. The gallery is truly stunning and is a cultural center and regional catalyst, inspiring creativity, providing accessibility to and promoting an understanding of the value of the arts. Eligibility and Acceptance

Open to all Signature members in good standing. You may submit up to three entries per artist. We will be accepting between 35-40 pieces in total for this exhibit.

Drop off and Pick Up of Artwork

Due to the distance of this exhibit, I am attempting to arrange several convenient, strategically located, drop off and pick up destinations for artwork to be collected and transported to and from the gallery to alleviate several long drives for our members.

In order to achieve this, we will need volunteers. Drivers can choose their preferred meeting location and set up a 20 minute time window for artists to arrive. Please consider if you would be willing to assist with one of the following responsibilities.

Please note that there is **no guarantee of transportation** of accepted artwork to and from the gallery. Should we not have enough volunteers, please be prepared to transport your work.

Gallery Commission

The Art League of Ocean City charges a 35% commission of all sales. Please price your work accordingly.

All works must be delivered framed under glass or plexiglass and ready to hang. Presentation should be professional-looking, suitable to the artwork, undamaged, reinforced, and with all wires and hardware securely attached. All mats and frames must be clean. ***The Maryland Pastel Society reserves the right to remove from the exhibition any paintings delivered with saw tooth hangers; metal clip frames; broken, missing, or unsafe hanging wire, as well as any cracked, damaged, or dirty glazing, matting, or framing.***
