A 4-day plein air pastel workshop with Margaret Evans is scheduled for May 29 – June 1, 2019. It will take place at several scenic locations in the Havre de Grace area, such as the Steppingstone Farm Museum, the old Gristmill, and downtown Havre de Grace by the shores of the Chesapeake Bay.

Margaret Evans is a Scottish contemporary artist and is one of the UK's leading art instructors, and is a fully qualified graduate of Glasgow School of Art, DA, and teaching graduate of London University, ATC. Margaret is a Signature member of the Pastel Society of America, Pastel Artists of Canada, Art du Pastel en France and LAI. Much of Margaret's life has been spent promoting and endorsing pastels as a truly serious and worthy medium for artists, and they continue to inspire and excite her whether used in dry or wet techniques. Her book, Pastels Unleashed, is a favorite resource for pastellists.

Margaret is an excellent, inspiring workshop instructor for all levels. Generous with information and help, she provides students with a great deal of individual attention. Margaret will help you enjoy developing your free spirit, to inject and reflect into your own paintings.
